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NOTICE: SPRAYING OF BROADLEAF AND OTHER WEEDS ON WELGEVONDEN ESTATE'S PUBLIC GREEN AREAS (LAWNS) AS WELL AS ALONGSIDE THE SECURITY FENCE

As required by the *Fertilizers, Farm Feeds, Agricultural Remedies and Stock Remedies Act (No 36 of 1947)* we hereby give notice that a contractor has been appointed to treat Welgevonden Estate's public green areas (including all trimmed grass areas), as well as the sections alongside the security fence, with herbicide to combat broadleaf and other weeds.

Planned dates and times of spraying:

Spraying will start on **Thursday, 16 July 2020, from 08:00 – 17:00** (not 9 July 2020 anymore, as previously notified), depending on the wind and the weather.

Areas to be treated:

- The main green belt from the R304 entrance, across Silver Oak Lane up to the fountain area in Welgevonden Boulevard South.
- The lawn located at the Welgevonden Boulevard and Welgevonden Boulevard South fork, adjacent to Olive and Sonnedou Streets.
- The lawn enclosed by Minaret, Perdevy and Protea Streets.
- All trimmed grass areas that are part of the estate's private open spaces.
- Both sides of Welgevonden Estate's security fence.

Details of the appointed contractor:

Henchem – company registration number 2018/390446/07 – has been appointed to do the work. The company is registered with the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (Registration number: P39004.)

Product to be used:

- Product Type: Herbicide, Herbicide non-crop.
- Where applied: Lawns, golf courses, bowling greens, sporting fields.
- Composition: Dicamba 120 g/L, 2,4-D 180 g/L, MCPA 157,5 g/L.

The product is administered by means of spraying and poses a low toxic risk to humans, animals and the environment. (Spray height will not exceed 500 mm.) It is, however, recommended that those suffering from asthma or other breathing problems keep their doors and windows closed while spraying is underway in their proximity.

Access to treated areas:

Treated areas can be accessed two (2) hours after spraying.

Please ensure that your family members, visitors, employees and others who might be on your premises are informed about the above and that they avoid the areas while spraying is underway and for two hours afterwards.

Important: Landlords are requested to inform their tenants accordingly.

General:

It is not possible to demarcate the areas to be treated due to their size and vastness, but notices will be put up to remind residents that spraying will take place.
